(The Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988)

It is illegal to Discriminate Against Any Person Because of Race, Color, Religion, Sex, Handicap, Familial Status, or National Origin

- In the sale or rental of housing or residential lots
- In advertising the sale or rental of housing
- In the financing of housing

- In the provision of real estate brokerage services
- In the appraisal of housing
- Blockbusting is also illegal

ON THE BASIS OF: Race, Creed, Color, National Origin, Ancestry, Nationality, Marifal or

Domestic Partnership or Civil Union Status, Familial Status, Sex, Gender Identity or Expression, Affectional or Sexual Orientation, Disability, Source of Lawful Income or Source of Lawful Rent Payment (Including Section 8)

BY: All Persons including Real Estate Agents or Brokers, Financial

Institutions, Property Owners, Landlords, or Building Superintendents,

and Their Agents and Employees

WITH RESPECT TO:
• The Sale, Rental or Lease of Real Property

Listing or Advertising of Real Property

Receipt or Transmittal of Offers to Purchase or Rent Real Property

Application and Terms of a Mortgage or Other Loan

REMEDY MAY INCLUDE: An Order Restraining Unlawful Discrimination, Reimbursement for

Financial Loss, Damages for Pain and Humiliation Experienced as a Result of Unlawful Discrimination, Punitive Damages, and

Attorney's Fees

It is also unlawful to publish real estate advertisements which express any discrimination against persons protected by the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, N.J.S.A. 10:5-1 et seq.
